Discover Poema del Mar: Best Aquarium in the Canary Islands

Get Yourself Lost in the Old Town of Vegueta

Vegueta is the heart of Las Palmas of Gran Canaria and it has more than five centuries of history. This unique old town preserves a peculiar architectural charm which invites you to get yourself lost in its narrow alleys. Some of its many emblematic attractions such as the Casa de Colón, the Cathedral of Santa Ana, the Museo Canario, the Gabinete Literario, the Casas Consistoriales and the chapel of San Antonio Abad, are a must if you visit Gran Canaria.

Admire the Beauty of La Caldera de Bandama

La Caldera de Bandama has existed from more than five billion years, and it is one of the most important volcanic complex of Gran Canaria. In the village of Santa Brígida you can find this natural landscape only available for those who venture to hike trough its paths.

Enjoy Hiking to El Roque Nublo

In the beautiful village of Tejeda, you can visit one of the largest natural monuments in the world and in Gran Canaria: El Roque Nublo. Along its 2 km path, hikers will enjoy the astonishing panoramic view.

In the southeast of Gran Canaria, we found the village of Agüimes and its historical centre of great cultural interest. Near to the town you will enter the fascinating Barranco de Las Vacas, one of the best kept secrets of the island. Its easy path and its stunning views make it the perfect family plan.

The Treasure of Maspalomas

This natural place, unique in the Canary Islands, is in the south of Gran Canaria. Along its 400 hectares, visitors can enjoy the excellent Maspalomas beach, surrounded by the dunes of organic sand and a small oasis with palm trees. This visit is a must that leaves nobody indifferent.

Lanzarote's Museum Route

One of the most popular attractions in Lanzarote is the Lagomar Museum, another work of the local artist César Manrique. This house, made up of caves and tunnels, is a place to get lost in nature. In the tour, you can discover different breathtaking rooms, full of vegetation and peculiar natural elements such as the island's own lava.


The wine lovers cannot lose the opportunity to visit the Wine Museum. This winery is the fifth oldest in Spain and it still preserves the tools and the fundamental elements for the production of wine, the star product of Lanzarote.

The Wonderful Cactus Garden and the Atypical Stratified City

In Teguise, located in the heart of Lanzarote, visitors can explore the last major work of César Manrique, El Jardín del Cactus (Cactus Garden). This fascinating place has about 4.500 species of cactus from all over the world.

The Stratified City is an extraordinary rock formation in Lanzarote. This series of atypical volcanic rocks have been shaped by thousands of years of wind, sun, and rain. Over time, the landscape continues to degrade and as a result and it is constantly changing.

Timanfaya National Park and El Charco de los Clicos

Visiting the Timanfaya National Park and the Charco de los Clicos you will discover the charms of the south of Lanzarote. In the Timanfaya National Park we invite you to discover the volcano route and admire the beauty of this protected volcanic landscape.

The famous Charco de los Clicos, also known as Charco Verde, is a very particular lagoon due to the striking green colour of the water. There is an easily accessible path to get a close look and admire this natural creation.



César Manrique Museum House

In the charming traditional village of Haría, you will have the privilege of visiting César Manrique House Museum, located in an impressive palm grove.

Visiting this place is a way of getting closer to the art of this significant painter, architect and sculptor in Lanzarote, since we have the opportunity to discover the studio where the artist used to do his magic.

A Window to the Archipelago Chinijo National Park

In the north of Lanzarote, we can find El Mirador del Río, which offers spectacular views of the Archipelago Chinijo National Park of Lanzarote. This spectacular viewpoint is one of César Manrique's most representative architectural works due to the harmonious formula that unites art and nature.

The Spectacular Cueva de Los Verdes and Los Jameos del Agua

La Cueva de los Verdes is a unique formation of extraordinary volcanological value. This grotto has a mysterious and special mythological character that can be appreciated thanks to a visible section formed by fascinating tunnels.

Los Jameos del Agua is the first Art, Culture and Tourism Centre created by César Manrique, in a natural space created inside a volcanic tunnel. The artist transformed the space into a unique work in the world that represents the perfect harmony between the environment and nature.

La Graciosa, Lanzarote's treasure

La Graciosa is a place to connect with nature, enjoy its quiet beaches of golden sand and turquoise water. Due to its small size, it can be visited in one day and get to discover its most secret corners. The landscapes and its simple routes, make this trip the perfect family plan.

This island is only accessible by boat from Órsola, the north of Lanzarote.

Fuerteventura's Museum Route

The Salinas del Carmen are the only salt mines in Fuerteventura that are still operational. During your visit you can be a salt maker for a day and get to know one of the most highly qualified salts thanks to the cleanliness of its waters.

Fuerteventura is one of the main producers of Aloe Vera in Spain. The island's weather conditions make it perfect for growing top qualified Aloe Vera. Therefore, we invite you to visit the Aloe Vera Museum and experience first hand the excellent work they do to obtain this beneficial product.

Enjoy Antigua and the Cheese Museum

Antigua is a charming village with great historical and artistic value. The windmill is the essence of its landscape, so visiting the Museo Molino de Antigua is a must. There, you can see how the maize flour was made in the past, which is the most typical product in the Canary Islands.

Majorero cheese is one of the most awarded cheeses in the world. In this Cheese Museum you will discover the secrets of this delights made with Fuerteventura's native goat's milk and all the different varieties you can imagine.

Natural Park of Corralejo and Grandes Playas

The dunes of the Corralejo Natural Park is the largest sand dunes of the Canary Islands and one of the undoubtedly most-visited natural areas in Fuerteventura. You can walk over kilometers of white sun, where you can take the most spectacular and fun photos. Very close to this Natural Park, you can stop by the Grandes Playas and have a relaxing time in the paradisaal beach of the island.

Isla de Lobos Natural Park

The lovely unequalled islet of Lobos is a protected natural area and one of the best preserved of the Canary Islands. The name Isla de Lobos is due to the fact that in the past Lobos used to be home of monk seals or sea lions, a species now extinct in the Canary Islands. Lobos is an accurate picture and an example of the way of living in the past: there are still preserved old ovens, wash houses, corrals and cisterns that are part of the rich heritage. The only way to get to this islet is taking a 20-minute boat ride from Corralejo.

The Heart of Fuerteventura

Betancuria is one of the most important villages of Fuerteventura, it is the oldest settlement on the island and its capital for five centuries.

After appreciating the historic buildings of the wonderful village of Betancuria, we will head to the Guise and Ayose viewpoint. This place has become an obligatory stop due to its impressive views and the huge statues of Guise and Ayose, the last aboriginal monarchs.

The end of this trip is the Ajuy Caves. To get to the caves you will only have to follow a simple, signposted path, which is itself a very particular rock formation. It is definitely worth going all the way to the end to appreciate an exceptional view of the ocean from a completely natural place.

A Hike to Calderón Hondo and the Discovery of the Popcorn Beach

One of the best preserved and easiest volcanic routes in Fuerteventura. There is no better way to admire the views of the north of the islands and the rest of the volcanic cones of the Bayuyo alignment, which erupted simultaneously 50,000 years ago.

Very close to this landscape you can discover the unusual beach of Bajo de la Burra, also known as Popcorn Beach. Can you guess why?

Windurf in Sotavento

Fuerteventura is the ideal island for water sports, in particular those that also need wind. Its characteristics and its summer climate throughout the year allow you to practice a wide variety of water sports modalities.

Every year the island receives thousands of international surfers who choose this destination for the great variety of beaches where they can enjoy windsurfing. One of the areas of the island where international windsurfing and kitesurfing events are held is Sotavento.
